## Origin:

The initial funds for the Al Nettles, Jr. Memorial Scholarship were donated in memory of Mr. Albert Alexander Nettles, Jr.

Mr. Al Nettles spent a lifetime managing well-loved family timberlands in Monroe County. He also dedicated decades of service to his community through the Kiwanis Club, Boy Scout Troop Number 24, the Monroe County Heritage Museum, the Monroe County Forestry Commission, and St. John's Episcopal Church, where he served on the vestry and was an Education For Ministry mentor for 15 years.

Al deeply loved God, his country, his community, his land, his family, and his friends. He was the most well-read but humble man in almost any room. He lived a life full of honor, integrity, and generosity, and his stories of adventure were beautifully told and a gift to all who heard them.

### Purpose:

The purpose of the Al Nettles, Jr. Memorial Scholarship is to provide financial assistance in the amount of \$500.00 toward forest and wildlife management education to one qualifying student from Monroe County school systems. Funds awarded may be used to pay or defray the cost of college expenses such as tuition, lab fees, books, etc.

# **Eligibility:**

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must be a Monroe County student and high school graduate accepted for admission to an approved college or university, junior college, or technical institute with a two year minimum program in forest or wildlife management education.

#### Selection:

Selection of scholarship recipients will be made by the Monroe County Forestry Committee.

#### **Deadline:**

Deadline for applications will be April 5, 2024. Scholarship recipients will be announced and notified mid May. Funds will be sent directly to recipient's attending college for use beginning Fall semester 2024.
